ACIPCO Federal CU's Board of directors voted to pay a 35% interest rebate/ dividend bonus for 2015. Members will receive a rebate of 35% of all interest paid to the Credit Union from Jan 1 -Sept 30, as well as a bonus dividend of 35% of dividends earned during that period. The Credit Union has been paying the rebate since 1993. Mike Harrell, former CEO, initiated the rebate program which has been proven to be one of his best decisions and one that our membership has appreciated year after year.

December 2015 will mark the 23rd consecutive year for the rebate and will bring the total to just over \$28 million returned to members.

Mobile transfers that put your money at your fingertips! Try our new Pocket 2 Pocket service! Reimburse your friends instantly and securely, with our mobile money transfer service! Pocket 2 Pocket will allow you to transfer funds from your account at ACIPCO Federal Credit Union, using your debit card, to another individual at any other institution. Visit **www.acipcofcu.org**, click on **E-SERVICES** then **Mobile Banking** and look for the Pocket 2 Pocket link. Send funds through text message or e-mail by entering the recipient's phone number or e-mail address.

*A \$2.00 fee applies per transfer. Transfer amounts apply toward your daily debit card transaction limit. The timing of the recipient receiving the funds may be delayed, depending on their financial institution.
