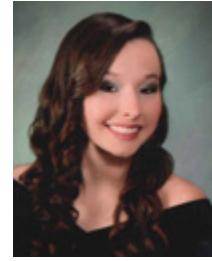

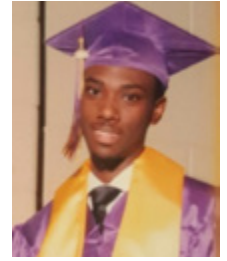

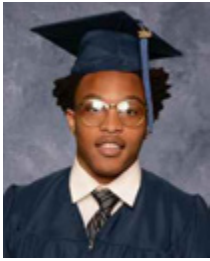

DOING OUR PART TO PROTECT YOU

Phishing, pharming, skimming, hacking. These may sound like some new sporting activity, but in fact they're just trendy names for stealing your money. And it seems like a new scheme is constantly being discovered. Fortunately, technology is adapting to provide more secure transactions and hopefully improve the situation for credit card fraud. Yes, I'm talking about EMV "chip cards" and they'll be replacing AFCU VISA credit cards in August. Chip cards are no silver bullet against fraud, but they provide significantly more security beyond what is capable with the magnetic stripe on traditional cards. Unfortunately, chip cards' enhanced protection is only useful with card present, or in person, transactions so online transactions are unaffected. Still, it's a giant step forward in fraud prevention.

Sadly, credit card fraud is only one of many ways criminals can steal from you. AFCU takes your security seriously and we strive to protect you in every way possible. Recently, we began offering a

new service - Member Security Center, an ID theft protection service offering multi-layered protection including credit monitoring, Internet surveillance, lost wallet protection, and ID theft insurance. Member Security Center is comparable to LifeLock in every area except price. (We'll leave the stealing to the crooks.) With plans starting at \$1.95, Member Security Center can save you up to 80%. Protecting your identity can save you apprehension, anguish, and wasted time. You can't put a price on those.
