ANOTHER GREAT REBATE

ACIPCO Federal CU's Board of directors voted to pay a 35% interest rebate/dividend bonus for 2016. Members will receive a rebate of 35% of all interest paid to the Credit Union from Jan 1 -Sept 30, as well as a bonus dividend of 35% of dividends earned during that period. The Credit Union has been paying the rebate since 1993. Mike Harrell, former CEO, initiated the rebate program which has been proven to be one of his best decisions and one that our membership has appreciated year after year.

December 2016 will mark the 24th consecutive year for the rebate and will bring the total to just over \$29.7 million returned to members.



STAY AHEAD OF DEBIT CARD FRAUD WITH TEXT ALERTS

The holiday season is a prime time for thieves looking to access your money. Take extra precautions against debit card fraud by signing up for text alerts through the ACIPCO mobile banking appavailable for free in the Apple App store and Google Play store. After downloading the app, you can register right from your phone. Once in the app, you can customize text alerts to notify you of activity on your account that may be out of your ordinary. You can also sign up for daily balance texts to help monitor unauthorized activity on your account.

As always, follow these tips to reduce your risk of card fraud:

- Keep your PIN a secret. Don't write it down, don't share it
- Don't let your card out of your sight
- Always use gas pumps in plain sight of store attendants. Be aware of the card reader if it feels loose it could have a skimmer installed on it.
- Avoid using ATMs at locations other than financial institutions (i.e. convenience stores, casinos)
- · Review your account activity often for signs of fraudulent activity

The same tips apply for credit cards, as well. You can set up alerts in AccessPoint for your ACIPCO VISA credit card through home banking.
